Schools

Anson residents are part of the award-winning Zionsville Community Schools system. Both elementary and middle schools are located less than one mile from Anson.

Healthcare and hospitals

Anson is 15 minutes from Witham Memorial Hospital in Lebanon, IN, and St. Vincent Hospital on Indianapolis' northwest side is 12 minutes away. An immediate care center with 24-hour emergency service is being built within the Anson community.

Zoning, annexation and address

Anson is annexed by Whitestown. Residents will have a Whitestown mailing address, since mail for this area is processed through the Whitestown post office. Zoned for mixed-use development as a Planned Unit Development (PUD) district, Anson is under the jurisdiction of the Boone County Area Plan Commission.
