

**ADVERTISEMENT TO BID
ANSON DEVELOPMENT – PHASE 2B
BOONE COUNTY, INDIANA**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Commissioners, Owner, at the Office of the Boone County Commissioners until 9:00 a.m., (local time), on **February 19, 2008**, and then will be publicly opened and read aloud at 10:00 a.m. (local time), the same day. Any bids received later than the above time will be returned unopened.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Work for which proposals are to be received is for the construction of infrastructure improvements along Anson Boulevard, County Road 450 South and County Road 500 East. The work consists of construction of approximately 1,500 feet of Anson Boulevard, south of CR 450 South; reconstruction of CR 450 South from Perry Worth Road to the Medco Site and improvements to CR 500 East from CR 400 South to CR 450 South.

BID DOCUMENTS: Copies of the Specifications and Contract Documents may be obtained at Butler, Fairman and Seufert, Inc., on Friday, February 1, 2008. Copies of the documents will be available for examining, on the above date, at the Boone County Highway Department, 1955 Indianapolis Avenue, Lebanon, Indiana and the office of the Engineer, Butler, Fairman and Seufert, Inc., 8450 Westfield Boulevard, Suite 300, Indianapolis, Indiana. Copies may be obtained at the office of the Engineer by remitting One Hundred Dollars (\$100) for each set. This remittance is not refundable. Payment shall be by money order or check and shall be made payable to Butler, Fairman and Seufert, Inc.

Bids shall be properly and completely executed on Bid Forms and in the order as identified and contained in the Contract Documents obtainable from the offices as stated above. Each bid shall be accompanied by a completely filled out Form No. 96 (Revised 2005) and acceptable Bid Security. Any bid not accompanied by the above-required items shall be deemed to be a non-responsive bid.

No Bidder may withdraw his proposal within a period of 60 days following the date set for the receiving of bids. The Owner reserves the right to retain any and all bids for a period of not more than 60 days and said bid shall remain in full force and effect during said time. The Owner further reserves the right to waive informalities and to award the Contract to any Bidder all to the advantage of the Boone County Board of Commissioners or to reject all bids.

BID SECURITY: Each bid shall be accompanied by an acceptable certified check made payable to the Boone County Board of Commissioners or an acceptable bid bond in the amount equal to Ten percent (10%) of the total bid price executed by an incorporated surety company in good standing and qualified to do business in the State of Indiana and whose name appears on the current Treasury Department Circular 570.

BONDS: A Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 110 percent of the Contract price will be required from the Contractor to whom the work is awarded.

INDIANA REQUIREMENTS: Standard Questionnaire Form 96 (Revised 2005), completely filled out and signed, including attachment of Contractor's Financial Statement as stipulated in Section III.
